Education and Experience

Terry earned his Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree from the Colorado School of Traditional Chinese Medicine in August 2006. This four-year program consists of 2,520 hours of education including 525 hours of clinical practice. He was certified as a Diplomate in Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in August 2006. This includes certification in Clean Needle Technique and Chinese Herbology. Terry earned his certification in Therapeutic Massage in 1999 from the Utah College of Massage Therapy. The nine-month program consisted of 1,143 hours of didactic and hands-on training.

Terry's training includes adjunctive therapies such as Cosmetic Acupuncture, Moxibustion, Tui Na, Swedish and Russian massage, Cranio-sacral therapy, Acupressure, Cupping, Auriculotherapy, and Dietary and Lifestyle recommendations.

Terry is a member of the Acupuncture Association of Colorado and the Associated Bodywork and Massage Professionals. He is a Licensed Acupuncturist and Registered Massage Therapist in Colorado.

This clinic complies with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Colorado Department of Health, including the proper cleaning and sterilization of needles and the sanitation of acupuncture offices. Only single-use, disposable, factory-sterilized needles are utilized.
